DUET investigates the two P's; pairs and power. Being on the verge of a breakup, Hanna and Heidi have decided to take up couple therapy. After 13 years together the two choreographers take a brutally honest look at themselves revealing a confused and disillusioned relationship. # **Creative Style &Influences**

Their work sits in between performance and dance and can be characterised as interdisciplinary, often taking a humorous approach to serious subject matters. Some recurring themes in their work are group behaviour, conformity, power and manipulation. The notion of the group versus the individual, the public and the private is investigated through mediums such as movement, voice and video performed in and outside of the black box.

The work examines the performer audience relationship, aiming to communicate directly with the audience, engaging in thoughts around human existence in contemporary society.

The choreography stems from the performers reactions and responses to systems, rules and game structures. The work is often juxtaposing humour with darkness, surface with underlying tension, perhaps not immediately recognisable to the audience however revealing itself throughout the performance.
