### Show Summary

Be enthralled by this epic musical folktale told on a miniature scale. A Heart at Sea brings to life the story of a young Boy who bottles up his heart and throws it into the sea. Using haunting live music and original song-writing our hero is plunged into a wild journey of discovery and danger to recover his missing heart. These songs knit together an atmospheric tale using loop pedals, vocals and instruments. A large, wooden, beautifully carved pop-up book on which puppets roam, accompanies these echoing soundscapes. Marvel as these backdrops pirouette and change as the Boy tumbles through a series of challenging events. This is a piece of stunning visual storytelling and atmospheric musical performance that will resonate with all ages.

A Heart at Sea is the collaboration between indie-folk artist Avi Simmons and visual artist/puppeteer Peter Morton. The piece was grown through a love for storytelling, music and puppets and was launched at Wise Words Festival (www.wisewordsfesitval.co.uk) in April 2016. Since A Heart at Sea has been awarded funding from the Art Council England and Canterbury City Council to finish the show ready for touring in Spring 2017.

#### **Artist Profiles**

A Heart at Sea is performed and was created through a collaboration between visual artist Peter Morton and musician Avi Simmons.



Peter is a visual artist who specializes in intricate puppet design and physical performance. He trained at the University of Kent in a Masters in contemporary performance and has since worked with a number of companies including Stuff and Nonsense, Sparkle and Dark, Theatre Témoin, Wide-Eyed, and The Big Reveal whilst also training with the National Theatre's War Horse. Peter is also Joint Artistic Director of Knuckle and Joint Theatre *Company* who create fun, dynamic puppetry performances ranging from large outdoor shows to intimate cabarets.

## **Technical Information**

The show has been designed to fit into intimate performance spaces with minimal technical requirements.

- Minimum Size of Stage Area:
  - o Width: 4m
  - o Depth 4m
- Minimal Sound requirement:
  - Sound System to support 2mics and Guitar; these are mixed on stage in a loop pedal and there is a standard jack output on this loop pedal.
  - One Fold-back speaker.
- Minimal Lights requirement:
  - A general wash focused onto stage area. More detailed and complex plans are available on request.
- Running Time: 45mins, No Interval.
