SHOW DESCRIPTION

MAPS is dance inspired by the theatre of the world, which explores a desired world without borders.

All maps are a snapshot in time, a fixed interpretation of our world, unable to capture the ebb and flow of people, places and politics. MAPS is a dance piece considering the world map through its constantly changing nature, as a moveable image and a portrait of how globalisation and freedom of information has broken our understanding of borders.

In collaboration with Dr Sarah Fine of Kings College London, Cartographer Yehuda Rubinstein and 50kgs of salt, MAPS takes the antique map of the world and fuses it into a culturally mixed, rhythmic and music flowing grove, revelling in a new cartography of the world. Running Time: 50 minutes

Sivan Rubinstein

Sivan Rubinstein is an Israeli choreographer based in London. She is a vivid

researcher and in dialogue with different art forms her work explores current issues through contemporary dance.

Sivan has been touring and teaching her work across The UK, Europe, Israel and LA and her work has been performed at major dance venues including, Sadlers Wells, The Place, Turner Contemporary, Richmix, JW3, Dance 4, and The Attenborough Centre, as well festivals at B.Motion Italy, Hangartfest Italy, The Dutch Dance Festival, and The Arts and Humanities Festival King's College London.



Sivan was awarded the title of 'Exceptional Artist' by the Israeli Ministry of Culture, and she was selected by The Place for Exit Visa, their 'emerging choreographer' program and as their UK artist for Pivot Dance. She Trained at Trinity Laban and today Sivan spends most of her time in the UK touring and developing her upcoming productions.

Sivan is also a member of the Swallowsfeet Collective who develop, curate and produce The Swallowsfeet Festival (Brighton) in partnerships with the Old Market Theatre, and South East Dance. The Collective bring opportunities to international artists to showcase their work, while creating a new platform for dance research and education. Website: sivanrubinstein.com
