
## THE PRODUCTION

The Hound of the Baskervilles was originally created in 2017 to run for 2 months in a purpose built theatre in Central Manchester, public demand quickly meant that we announced a 3 month extension. With a sell-out run under our belts, the show transferred in a larger production to the Epstein Theatre in Liverpool.

The show returned in a new production for a sell-out run in October 2018 at The Lowry, Salford, and a 5 week run at the Drayton Arms Theatre, London over Christmas 2018

The new production commences it's first UK Tour on 8th May.

We are confident that the runaway success the production has enjoyed in Manchester & London will translate well on UK Tour.



#### THE AUDIENCE


We reccommend that the production is marketed to a traditional theatre going audience (35+) as well as younger audiences who enjoy comedy (25 - 35).




