

The Bird Show – A flap-tastic family comedy by The Last Baguette

With frolics and foraging, flitting, flying and two unusual feathery friends, this is a madcap and touching show about birds facing changes to their habitat. The Bird Show uses live music, puppetry and lots of silly bird jokes in this heart-fluttering physical comedy.

We follow Henry the Heron and Sally the House Sparrow on a zany journey to become friends while facing ecological threats to their habitat. This colourful, visual show gently explores the impact of humans on nature and asks the question - what can we do differently?

We usually offer a meet and greet after the show for about 10 minutes, where audience members can try out the puppets, have a go on bits of the set, and meet the characters.

Audience experience: (a more informal text to describe the show to potential audience members)

The Bird Show is a fun fact-filled family comedy about a zany friendship between a Heron and a House Sparrow, and the environmental challenges they face. The show uses visual storytelling, physical comedy and puppetry and is performed by two actors and a banjo-ukulele.

Sally the House Sparrow and Henry the Heron live on a landfill site. Henry claims his previous abode was a lake in the grounds of a castle, but the dump is all Sally has ever known. One morning Henry is preparing to emigrate to more salubrious climes, when an unexpected event delays his flight plans....

This is a madcap and touching show about the challenges birds face in relation to their changing environment. The audience will laugh and care for these fierce and proud feathered friends.

We are excited to be working with designer Bronia Housman to create the set and puppets from recycled and found materials.

The total running time is 1 hour. We recommend the show for anyone age 3+, but younger children are always welcome.

Workshops

We love engaging with audiences of all ages beyond the auditorium.

We are offering 2 workshops to accompany the show. These are 1-2 hours long each, and are aimed at primary school age children, but we are happy to adapt them to different ages or specific groups as required.

Recycled Rascals puppetry workshop: A puppetry workshop based on making puppets out of found materials – the workshop includes an element of performance with students invited to create and present their puppet characters at the end of the workshop.

Kooky Kharacters theatre workshop: a fun and relaxed theatre workshop. Find out about how to develop characters using animals as inspiration. Create your own scenes and stories, and learn about improvisation and physical comedy.

Participants will learn about theatre, create their own work, build confidence, make new friends and have fun!

We can also create tailored workshops on request for all ages and abilities – please just ask! We regularly run workshops on physical comedy, developing characters, improvisation and creating devised work.

THE LAST BAGUETTE - ABOUT THE COMPANY:

The Last Baguette makes fast-paced, irreverent physical comedy. We are company in residence at Pound Arts, Corsham and tour to theatres, rural touring venues and arts centres across the country. We have performed in the UK, France, Switzerland and Canada.

The company was formed from a shared love of theatre, bakery and humour in Paris by graduates of the Philippe Gaulier and Jacques Lecoq schools. We believe in the power of physical comedy and silliness to talk about important issues of our times.

We tour shows, lead the Pound's Youth theatre, run one off workshops and community projects. We are excited by the possibilities of art bringing people together and believe theatre can be catalyst for change. We are proud to work with our Paris-based sister association Malafesta to bring European artists to the UK. The theatre we make is entertaining, accessible and eccentric.

In 2017 and 2018/9 we created and toured the Arts Council supported show The Little Match Girl. We performed to sell out audiences across the southwest and midlands. While company in residence at Pound Arts we also created the Arts Council supported shows Dracula – A Terrifying Comedy, and What's the Matter? a physical comedy about physics which have toured to theatres, festivals, arts centres and schools from 2015 - 2017. These followed Shake!!! William Speare, a multilingual comedy based on "A Midsummer Night's Dream" directed by Aitor Basauri (Spymonkey), which was performed in France, Switzerland and Canada.
