Suitability / Target Audiences

- The production is ideally suited to children age 6 and their grown ups
- The fable is within the Key Stage 1 drama curriculum, making the performance suitable for summer school clubs.
- Due to the relaxed nature of the performance, the show is suitable for some children with disabilities. We are happy to allow families early access to the space if this is helpful.
- The show features live music by award-winning jazz, blues and funk musician and percussionist Hannabiell Sanders, so will appeal to families who love music and dancing.
- The show is very flexible and can pop up in unlikely spaces. Sound is played live on stage with no power needed.



Company Requirements

The Tortoise and the Hare - A Suitcase Story is a new small scale production suitable for performing in studio theatres, libraries and community venues.

Ideally we'd perform on a flat floor to up to 100 audience members, but we can perform to raked audiences too.

We require:

- A space 4m wide to perform
- Parking for a long wheel base van
- Access to the space for a 2 hour get in

Technical details

The show is suitable for small scale touring.

All sound is live and operated on stage.

We have a simple LX design and ask for a venue technician to operate the show for us. We provide a basic LX plan in advance. In community spaces the show can be run without an LX rig.
