WEX-FACTOR

PREPARES PUPILS FOR THEIR WORK EXPERIENCE AND THE WORLD OF WORK

The production comprises a game show with two teams competing against each other. The show has five rounds, each highlighting one area of work experience and points are awarded at the end of each round. The areas covered are as follows:



Interview Technique – preparation for an interview including initial telephone conversation with prospective employer.



Employer's Expectations – allows students to gain some insight into what employers expect of students during their work experience placement.



Dress to Impress - helps students with their decision as to what to wear during their placement including appropriate dress, health and safety, and hygiene.



Customer Service - allows the students to identify good and bad customer service which helps them during their work experience placement.



Health and Safety – demonstrates what students need to know about Health and Safety in the work place.

● INTRODUCES PUPILS TO THE IDEA OF BUSINESS AND ENTERPRISE

The show is an interactive game show in which the pupils compete in various rounds to win key skills needed to be enterprising. They will then use these skills in the final round to meet the Dragons in the Dragons' Den. The show is a fun way to look at Business and Enterprise, what it takes to set up a business and such key skills as ability to plan, confidence, motivation, self-awareness, competitive drive, willing to work hard, willing to learn, perseverance, creativity, willing to assume a risk, and ability to communicate.

The workshop enhances pupils' communication skills in the workplace and in everyday life. This workshop uses a number of drama games, team building exercises and improvised scenes to look at the following areas: different types of communication, team building, body language, eye contact, listening, tone of voice, non verbal communication, telephone conversations, interview techniques and customer service.
